#### Photos of Speed Indicator Signs (SID)s

These replaced existing SIDs that were no longer functioning and had gone beyond economical repair.

These are important road safety devices that help monitor and reduce traffic speed on a high traffic volume road. The new SIDs have counted 500,000 vehicles in one month on the Lavenham Road alone.
