

## **Great Waldingfield Parish Council. Environment Report - February 2026**

Thankfully it has been a quiet year so far with regards to poor weather, lets hope this continues.

Footpath 11 - we are still waiting for SCC 's contractors to give us a start date for improvements here. Some cutting back has been done and we have used some of the shredded material to lay on the footpath making it less muddy.

The situation with the stream alongside FP11 continues. Anglian Water seem very slow to do anything so we will engage our contractor to start to clear the vegetation at the Folly Road end of the stream and send the invoice to Anglia Water.

December 2025 – Suffolk Wildlife Trust visited the GWWA and were really impressed to find an area given over completely to nature. We are hoping they will install a Barn Owl nest box for us and there is discussion about the possibility of digging out a large pond later in the year.

We now have a compost bin for the Village Hall, it just needs to be sited.

In the coming months we are hoping to run a Litter Pick and a seed planting activity.
